Day 7 | Explore Badlands National Park

Mount Rushmore Evening Lighting Ceremony - Mount Rushmore springs to life as you join a Park Ranger in an outdoor amphitheater for a moving patriotic program and sculpture lighting ceremony. You'll start with listening to a short inspirational talk, focusing on the presidents, patriotism and the nation's history, followed by a 20-minute film, "Freedom: America's Lasting Legacy." Watch in wonder as the evening culminates in the slow exposure of light, gradually illuminating the four presidents faces against the backdrop of the Black Hills dark sky (seasonal).
